
### **Senate Bill 159 Implementation**


California Pharmacists' Perspectives on Opportunities and Challenges

Senate Bill 159 (SB 159), passed in 2019, allows California pharmacists to prescribe PEP and 60 days of PrEP for HIV prevention without an outside provider's prescription.

In 2022, we conducted an online survey among 919
California pharmacists and pharmacy students to understand their perspectives on the provision of HIV prevention services in pharmacies.

### Key Barriers to Implementing SB 159




