
HIV and Syphilis: Rising Rates for Men who have Sex with Men (MSM)



In Los Angeles County, 60% of MSM diagnosed with early syphilis were also living with HIV

Recommendations

Increasing provider education about the CDC recommendation for annual STI screening for MSM and PLWH. Women living with HIV are tested less frequently than men, and should be a target audience for enhanced testing.

2 Encouraging providers to obtain sexual histories, in order to identify patients at risk of STIs and HIV.

3 Including a prompt within the electronic medical record, to remind providers to screen for syphilis as a component of regular care and in PrEP monitoring visits.

4 Adding routine STI screening for MSM and PLWH as a quality of care metric (e.g. Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS)) for all health plans, including Medicare and Medicaid-funded services.
