#### TRANSGENDER PEOPLE LIVING WITH DIAGNOSED HIV



In California, the number of transgender people living with diagnosed HIV rose from 2016 to 2020






Transgender people make up 1.6% of all people living with diagnosed HIV in California

Yet, in 2020, transgender people comprised 3% of all those newly diagnosed with HIV




As of 2020, ~3 out of 4 (76%) transgender people living with diagnosed HIV in California identify as Black or Latinx



#### **HIV CARE CONTINUUM**

**Transgender People Newly Diagnosed with HIV** 





In 2020, far smaller proportions of newly diagnosed Black transgender people were linked to HIV care in one month, retained in HIV care, and achieved viral suppression in six months

In 2019 and 2020



Viral suppression declined

**♦** 3% for trans women, 6% for trans men





Fewer retained in care

**♦** 8% for trans women, 16% for trans men
